Case Study

- Scott, a 19-year-old who was visiting his cousin Matt at a local college campus decided to attend a party given by a graduate student
- Before leaving for the party, at 10:00 PM, Matt warned Scott to stick to punch or sodas and not to drink any alcoholic beverages
- He also advised him not to leave his drink unattended
- Scott promised and consumed a total of three glasses of fruit punch; He did not consume any alcohol
- At 3:00 AM when the party was winding down and Matt was ready to go home he was unable to locate his young cousin
- Scott was found unconscious at about 3:45 AM lying in a fetal position; He was nude from the waist down and bleeding from his rectum
- There was also evidence of vomitus and bruise on his left cheek
- The police were called and Scott was rushed to the emergency room
- Two hours later, Matt was told that Scott was raped and did not want to see him or anyone else.
